

Troop 57 Fall Cycling Trip (25 Miler or 50 Miler)

Leaving the Scout House, we will bike up into the beautiful Crystal Springs watershed, along Canada Road and Sawyer Camp Trail. This is a fantastic ride, including stops at Pulgas Water Temple (see picture above) and the Jepson Laurel (oldest and largest known Laurel in California).

Merit Badge: Successful completion of this ride will knock off one of the three big rides required for the Cycling Merit Badge.

Prerequisites: Prior participation in a Troop bike ride or an avid cyclist accustomed to 15+ mile rides.

Gear: Bicycle in good working condition (road bike or “slicks” recommended)
Helmet and suitable clothing (highly visible)
Bag lunch and snacks
At least 2 liters of water in bottles or backpack bladder
Cycling merit badge blue card
