Ocean Rockfishing Trip September 24-25, 2010



- You **WILL catch fish** (last year EVERY scout caught fish; you will, too)

- You have a good chance of seeing **whales** and/or a **great white shark**,
- You will have an opportunity to earn credit toward the **Fishing Merit Badge**
- We've chartered the **WHOLE boat**, but space is limited, so **SIGN UP EARLY!**

Sign-up & Cost: A check payable to "Troop 57 BSA" for **\$105** is due by **Monday, September 19th** at the home of trip coordinator, Cecile Barry. Due to restrictions on the number of campers and people on the boat, **THIS TRIP WILL CLOSE ONCE WE REACH THE TRIP LIMIT (24 people)**. **YOUR SPOT IS NOT GUARANTEED UNTIL THE TRIP COORDINATOR HAS RECEIVED YOUR CHECK. FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED!**

Campout: Overnight at Butano State Park (http://www.parks.ca.gov/?page_id=536)

Food & Gear: Saturday dinner, Sunday breakfast and drinks on the boat (water, ginger ale and iced tea) are included in the trip cost, as are bait, tackle and tip on the boat. **Bring your own lunch to eat on the boat on Sunday.** A pack list will be distributed beforehand by e-mail.

Boat Details: We will carpool from the campsite to **Pillar Point Harbor in Half Moon Bay** to arrive at 6:00 AM on 9/24. Everyone **16 or older must have a current fishing license**, which can be obtained on the boat (bring \$14 cash with you for a day license). Also bring \$10 if you want your fish cleaned for you on board the boat.

***Sea Sick Meds:** You are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to **bring and take medication for motion sickness**. Bonine and "Less Drowsy" formula Dramamine are available OTC. **SCOPOLOMINE**(Patch), **SCOPACE** (pills; see <http://www.motionsickness.net/>) works extremely well (with no drowsiness) but requires a **doctor's prescription**. Sometimes you can phone in a request to your doctor.

Weather: Your money will be refunded if we cancel the trip due to weather.
