MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Troop 57 at Camp Oljato

THE LAW OF CAMP:

The law at Camp Oljato is simple, but inclusive -- the Scout Oath and Law.

GENERAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS:

- Scouts are expected to participate actively in camp and troop activities, to work on advancement and to show Scout Spirit.
- Horseplay can result in injury and damage to equipment. Hazing: There is no hazing of any type allowed at Oljato. PERIOD. Remember the Golden Rule.
- Appropriate Scout uniforms will be worn as directed by the SPL and SM .. cheerfully.

FLAMMABLES:

Extreme fire hazards during summer months mean that all campers must use great caution with any form of fire and comply with established fire safety rules at all times.

- Only natural wood, charcoal or propane will be used for cooking purposes. No white gas.
- The troop will provide a Troop propane lantern for outside use. Only battery operated lanterns are allowed in the tents.
- Butane lighters are not permitted and will be confiscated.
- Matches must be used properly and only when approved.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED IN CAMP:

Alcohol and Illegal Substances; Firearms, Sheath or Large Knives, Spears, Bows and Arrows and Ammunition; Fireworks, Offensive Material of any kind, Electronics such as Radios, IPODs, Personal Tape or CD players.
