

# NEW TROOP 57 HISTORIC TRAILS HIKE

Sunday, November 13, 2011



Be in the first group of Troop 57 Scouts to hike the historic route developed by the Pacific Skyline Council and earn the unique patch pictured above. This 12.4 mile hike connects the three camps used by peninsula Scouts over the past century. We will begin at the Cutter Scout Camp (used from the 1970's to the present), and then travel back in time to Camp Pomponio (1940's – 1960's) before ending in Memorial Park, the site of Pescadero Camp (1920's – 1940's). We have permission from the San Mateo County Sheriff's Dept. to hike through the old Camp Pomponio, which was converted to a jail in the 1970's. Don't worry. The jail is now closed.

*The route will fulfill the requirements for a 10 mile hike for the Hiking merit badge.*

- Date:** November 13, 2011  
**Time:** Leave Scout House at 7:00 AM and return late afternoon.  
**Food:** Bring a sack lunch, snacks, and two bottles of water  
**Other:** 10 essentials, and don't forget the rain jacket.
